Shape - A design element Definition -
A. An area that stands out because of a boundary.
B. A line that meets itself.

Basic shapes: circle, square, rectangle, triangle, oval

1. Implied shape - A shape that is suggested because of dots, dashes or edges.

Design elements: Smallest units of design Line, shape, texture, value, space, form, color.

2. Geometric shapes - shapes that have a mathematical name.

Ex. Circle, square, rectangle, triangle, oval or trapezoid.
3. Symbol shape - a symbol shape is a shape that stands for something else. Ex. Heart, Cross, four leaf clover, Star.
4. Organic shapes - shapes that are from nature and don't have a mathematical name. A free form shape.

Ex. A puddle, a Cloud, A milk spill
5. Positive shape - the shape of the object.
6. Negative shape - the shape of the space around the objects.
7. Static shape - a tall square building is static/ low energy.
8. Dynamic shape - a roller coaster/ high energy.
9. Shapes are two dimensional - 2D
