Shape – A design element

Definition -

- A. An area that stands out because of a **boundary**.
- B. A **line** that meets itself.

Basic shapes: circle, square, rectangle, triangle, oval

- 1. Implied shape A shape that is suggested because of dots, dashes or edges.
- 2. **Geometric** shapes shapes that have a mathematical name.
- Ex. Circle, square, rectangle, triangle, oval or trapezoid.
- 3. **Symbol** shape a symbol shape is a shape that stands for something else. Ex. Heart, Cross, four leaf clover, Star.
- 4. **Organic** shapes shapes that are from nature and don't have a mathematical name. A free form shape.
- Ex. A puddle, a Cloud, A milk spill
- 5. Positive shape the shape of the **object**.
- 6. Negative shape the shape of the space **around** the objects.
- 7. Static shape a tall square building is static/ low energy.
- 8. Dynamic shape a roller coaster/ high energy.
- 9. Shapes are **two** dimensional 2D
